Parents

98% of parents say their child is happy at school

We have been very pleased by the results of parental questionnaires and the results of this have been reinforced by a recent visit from our School Improvement Partner.

Pupils

99% of pupils who always or mostly like being in this school

93% of pupils who always or mostly have a good playtime.

Following these results we have reviewed lunchtime and playtime activities and the concerns raised by the children have since been addressed.

Headlice

We have experienced a high level of headlice during the last few weeks. We do need everyone to take responsibility for this problem and please check their children regularly. If you find your child does have headlice or any eggs, please ensure you wash their hair with conditioner and use a headlice comb. Once clear, this should be repeated every three days for at least two weeks to ensure all eggs have been found.
